PLEASE NOTE:

The process of reviewing your submission may take up to several months. You will receive a response after we have had a chance to look at your images.

We cannot make studio visits, see the work in person or make visits to private collections during the initial phase of the review. If there is sufficient interest we will contact you about any next steps.

While we are happy to review your work, our exhibition schedule is planned several years in advance. Our gallery is a program of our Taube Center for Jewish Peoplehood and exhibits require Jewish theme(s), inspiration(s) or topic(s) to be considered. We are rarely able to accommodate unsolicited submissions for exhibitions.
