
What it IS...

Say Blessings & light the Hanukkah

The hanukkah (menorah) holds 9 candles, one for each night of the story and a shamash (helper) to light the others.

THE Hanukkah (MENORAH)

Different households have different customs when it comes to lighting the hanukkah. Some start the holiday with one candle and increase with each day, others begin by lighting all eight and decrease each day. Some households only light one hanukkah while others have one for each member of the family.

Blessings are recited first, then candles are lit from left to right.

Baruch ata Adonai, Eloheinu melech ha'olam asher kidshanu b'mitzvotav, ve-tzevanu lihadlik ner shel Hannukah.

Play *Dreidel* a 4-sided spinning top game.



Dreidel was created as a cover for Torah study when the Torah was forbidden.

Players get gelt (chocolate coins) & do what comes up on their spin.

Whoever has the most gelt at the end wins!

These Hebrew letters stand for *Nes Gadol Haya Sham*, a great miracle happened there.
