

Meet Vivian

Four generations of **Vivian Cohen**'s family have enaged in Jewish culture and built community at the JCC. Her parents Anette and Herbert Heller, of blessed memory, joined the JCC in 1961 to enroll Vivian and her twin sister in our nursery school. When Vivian and her husband Emil Areton became parents, they sent their four children to the same preschool. Next year, her eldest granddaughter will attend and create her own friendships and memories at the JCC.

"I've been a member my whole life, and I see the future generation, my grandchildren, continuing. So it's going to be generation to generation to generation."

Sixty years after first joining, Vivian still visits the JCC several times a week – to work out at the fitness center, attend a Jewish peoplehood program, or participate on the JCC board. Vivian describes her experience at the JCC affectionately. "I can't get enough of this place. I just love walking through the door every day. You just feel a sense of belonging and love and kindness here. Every day is a new memory."

Meet Tom

Legendary football coach at Marin Catholic High School, **Tom Shershanovich**, has been a devoted member of the Osher Marin JCC for 32 years. He can see the JCC from his hilltop home in San Rafael. As a football coach who trained athletes, Tom praises the JCC's equipment and facilities: "There's no other place that I know of around here that could compare the JCC."

Tom suffered from severe degenerative arthritis, partly due to his profession, and only after multiple knee surgeries was he ready to return to the JCC. Three times a week Tom benefits from personal training, working on weights, riding a stationary cycle, and swimming lengths. "I had a tough time standing", says Tom, "the JCC brought me back to life. It saved my life."

Tom also enjoys the fact that the JCC is a warm, welcoming, inclusive community, open to all. "I look forward to getting up and coming to the JCC. Mainly I look forward to seeing my friends and the people who work here. I love these people, they are always happy."

Though they met through exercise classes, they all agree that it is the friends they've made that keeps them coming back year after year. "It is a testimony to the friendships that we have developed here that during the COVID pandemic we had Zoom meetings of our group, every Friday," shared Barbara Cate.

Each one cites compelling reasons for coming to the JCC. Carol Sachal summed up what others were saying, "Water aerobics are absolutely magic. It's what I love...And I love all the people in my classes." They highlight the wonderful instructors, the diversity, and the beautiful facility. While applauding the therapeutic benefits of group exercise, especially in the pools, they emphasize the importance of experiencing all these programs with friends in community. For many, the J has been part of their entire lives, part of their families' lives, and has become their second home.

Evi Rachelson estimates that she's taught 1,750 students in her 38 years at the JCC Preschool, and she takes pride in helping so many start their Jewish journeys. "I like to teach my students not only the joy of learning, but also the Jewish joy of learning," says Evi. "I try to instill Judaism in a fun way, so that it goes into their body and hearts, and hopefully they will pass their love on to the next generation."

In fact, many of Evi's former students grow up to send their children to the JCC Preschool, like **Justin Patrizio** and his son, **Roman**. "I have many fond, formative memories from my time at the JCC," recalls Justin. "We chose the JCC for Roman's preschool because of the teachers like Evi, who provide such a great foundation for our kids."

"I'm delighted that I'm teaching the next generation," says Evi, "and who knows, maybe I'll end up teaching the grandchildren of some of my students. The JCC is an amazing place and I love what I do."

Programs for Everyone

Toddlers & Preschoolers

Our Early Childhood Education Centers in San Rafael and Mill Valley offer a variety of infant and baby programs and provide toddler, preschool, and pre-K (transitional kindergarten) programs for children ages 18 months to five years, with a focus on universal, values-based learning.



The Toole Center for Youth & Family offers year-round programs for children, teens, and families. In addition to hosting special events for Jewish holidays, it is also home to Camp Kehillah, a popular summer and vacation camp serving youth across the community.

Adults

The Kurland Center for Adult Learning & Living provides lifelong learners with a range of enriching experiences, from classes and local excursions to musical matinees and international trips. We also offer exercise programs for seniors and Israeli folk dance sessions.













Performing Arts

The Kanbar Center for Performing Arts showcases world-class performances, including the popular outdoor Summer Nights and indoor Winter Nights concert series, which often attract over a thousand attendees from across the community.

Jewish Culture

The Taube Center for Jewish Peoplehood offers programs, thought-provoking discussions, and holiday celebrations that honor Jewish values and traditions. Our events welcome people of all ages, beliefs, and interests.

Fitness & Aquatics

Our award-winning Koret Center for Health & Fitness features an Aquatics Center with both indoor and outdoor pools, a full gymnasium, personal trainers, a sauna, a spa, and over 50 weekly fitness classes, including Pilates, Yoga, Indoor Cycling, and TRX.
